- Pontos de vista a considerar (histórico, sociológico, económico, etc.)
- Língua em que se pretende a informação

# COMO INICIAR UMA PESQUISA BIBLIOGRÁFICA

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## ONDE? (Locais de pesquisa)

- Qual o contexto geográfico  
País ou região?
- Fontes de informação (web, fora dela...)

## Estratégias da pesquisa

- No início de uma pesquisa começa por se escolher **um/o tema**.
  - Acontece frequentemente haver escolhas por "**grandes temas**" o que pode traduzir-se em dispersão e **ruído de respostas**  
Exp. Violência
  - Mas também **temas demasiado limitados** podem trazer **silêncio na resposta**  
Exp. Interpretação a nível comunitário dos maus tratos em crianças pequenas



# Estratégias da pesquisa

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## A MEDIDA JUSTA

### Centrar-se

- num único assunto
- num grupo específico
- num certo período temporal
- numa causa, ou num efeito
- num argumento, ou num ponto de vista

### Depois

- Definir um tema e focalizar-se nas palavras mais importantes do mesmo

# Estratégias da pesquisa

## Palavras-Chave / Key-Words

- Um mesmo conceito pode exprimir-se por diferentes palavras
  - Devem definir-se as palavras chave através de tesouros, dicionários, artigos de revistas, etc.
  - Pesquisas rápidas em bases de dados permitem também perceber quais os termos utilizados para determinados conceitos
  - Ter em atenção a língua das bases de dados  
Normalmente são de origem anglo-saxónica
- Não esquecer: Os grandes motores de busca respondem por palavras e não por conceitos / ideias

# Truques para a internet

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**DIRECTÓRIOS – Usar termos genéricos (devido às categorias)**

**MOTORES - Usar termos específicos (p. evitar ruído)**

**LÍNGUA – Fazer a pesquisa na língua do motor**

**TIPO DE PALAVRAS – Usar substantivos (adj., verbos, pronomes, adv. quando usados entre “ “)**

**Nº E ORDEM DAS PALAVRAS – Não começar com mais de 3 colocando a palavra mais importante em 1º lugar**

# Estratégias da pesquisa

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- Suprimir pontuação
- Suprimir palavras vazias (artigos, conjunções)
- Usar de preferência termos específicos

Ex.

Como é que a **bebida** afeta o **desempenho** dos **alunos universitários**?

Para cada palavra-chave procurar **sinónimos**

Bebida = drinking, ou alcohol, alcohol abuse, alcoholism

Desempenho = performance

Alunos universitários = university students ,  
academic students

Among the Al-Sayyid Arab-Bedouin, the use of an indigenous sign language is widespread and provides the foundation of a signing community shared by hearing and deaf people. Cases with comparable high incidences of deafness have in recent years stimulated debates in diverse academic disciplines. Lacking an accurate term, they are regularly referred to as "Martha's Vineyard situations" and have often been oversimplified and romanticized. This article provides an in-depth analysis of a Bedouin shared-signing community and advocates closer investigation of both facilitating and disabling social practices, which would also allow better examination of comparable cases. This article concentrates on the shared use of sign language, the asymmetry it entails, and the manifold forms of translation and mediation that take place. Whereas most hearing Al-Sayyid persons have access to both spoken and signed modes of communication, deaf people's communication remains largely restricted to the signed mode (hence, the asymmetry). However, in contrast to the common reduction of deafness to the disabling absence of speech or need for translation, deaf people's need for translation is not unusual among the Al-Sayyid; local communication patterns involve many different forms of translation between different spoken languages, written languages, discourses, and social domains. Additionally, ample translators are readily available. Moreover, the common familiarity with deaf people and sign language facilitates the production and sharing of a unique experiential knowledge, grounded in daily experiences and practices. In this context, deafness is not easily subjugated to its medical model. However, encounters with the medical and educational establishment present a series of challenges that may severely exacerbate deaf people's structure of...

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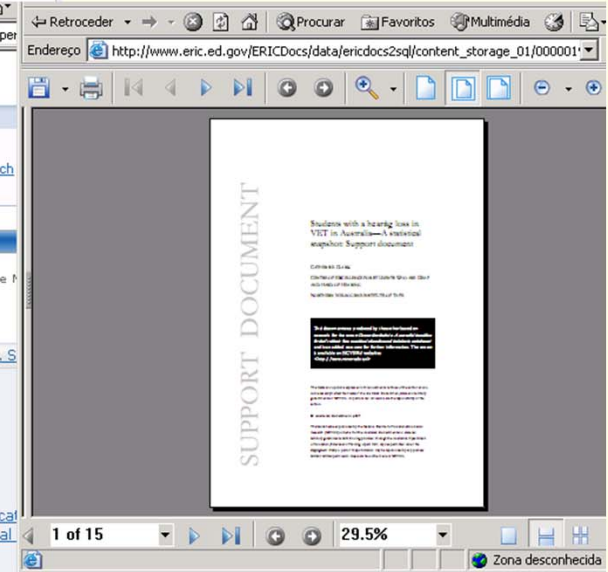

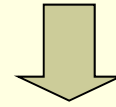

# COMO PESQUISAR NUMA BASE DE DADOS

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## Normas de utilização

- Identificação do assunto
- Escolha das palavras chave (termos específicos)
- Procurar na base o Thesaurus ou lista de termos usados (ver os termos genéricos específicos e associados às nossas palavras chaves)
- Trabalhar com operadores lógicos
- Nos casos decepcionantes, alterar e modificar a pesquisa (limitar por datas, país, língua, usar outros sinónimos e termos mais genéricos)



## COMO PESQUISAR NUMA BASE DE DADOS

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- Habitualmente, as bases de dados disponibilizam dois tipos de pesquisa

**Pesquisa simples** - permite pesquisas apenas num campo.

**Pesquisa avançada** - permite pesquisas em vários campos bem como permite a utilização de **auxiliares de pesquisa** (operadores booleanos, truncatura, etc.)

Neste últ. caso deve seleccionar-se o campo onde se deseja fazer a pesquisa (autor, título, assunto, etc.)

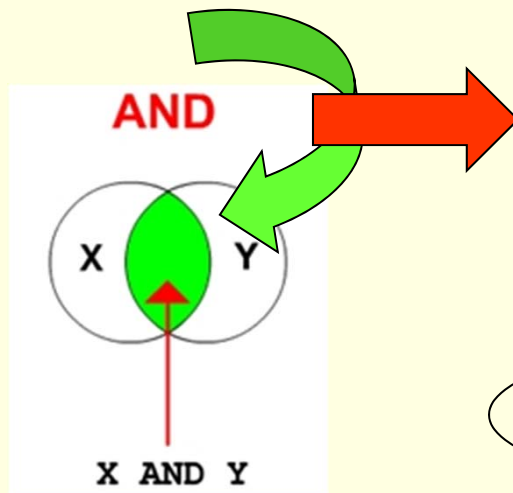

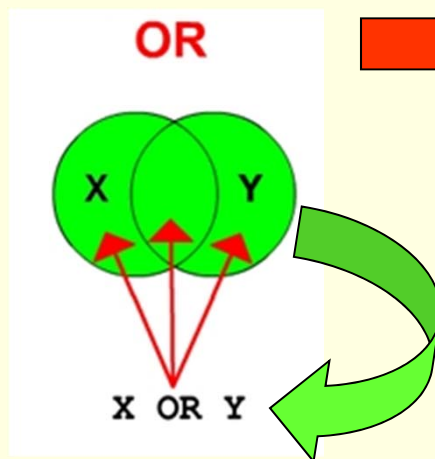

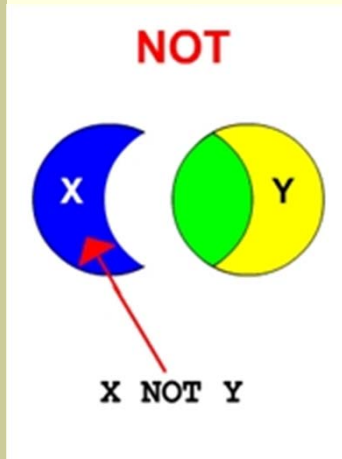

Permite encontrar variantes de um termo, formas singular/ plural ou mascarar uma letra

? ou \$ mascaram uma letra em qualquer parte da palavra

\* Substitui uma sequência de caracteres



# Auxiliares de pesquisa

? ou #

- Recuperam singular/plural ou todas as formas da raiz da palavra

Ex. Apenas um caracter - *WOM?n*

- Um ou mais caracteres partindo da raiz da palavra

Ex. *child\** (*child, children, childhood*)

Nota: Permite pesquisas na raiz de um termo ou substitui um carater quando não sabemos bem a ortografia

### Alargar uma pesquisa

- Fazer a pesquisa em texto livre
- Procurar outros termos no âmbito dos conceitos pretendidos
- Usar a truncatura para encontrar palavras com raiz comum
- Pesquisar nos abstracts

## Dicas úteis

---

### Restringir uma pesquisa

- Encontrar outros conceitos que melhor identifiquem o assunto
- Restringir por título e frases exactas
- Usar operadores de proximidade **adj near with** em vez de **and**
- Limitar por anos, tipo de documentos, língua

## Dicas úteis

---

- Nunca esquecer de consultar o índice ou o thesaurus (caso exista)
- Índice - mostra os termos existentes na base  
(Autor(es), títulos, assuntos, etc.)
- Thesaurus - além dos termos específicos mostra os termos genéricos, e associados  
(Termos de indexação ou descritores)
